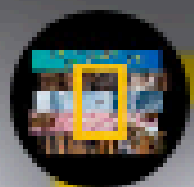
WHY IS LOGGING BAD?

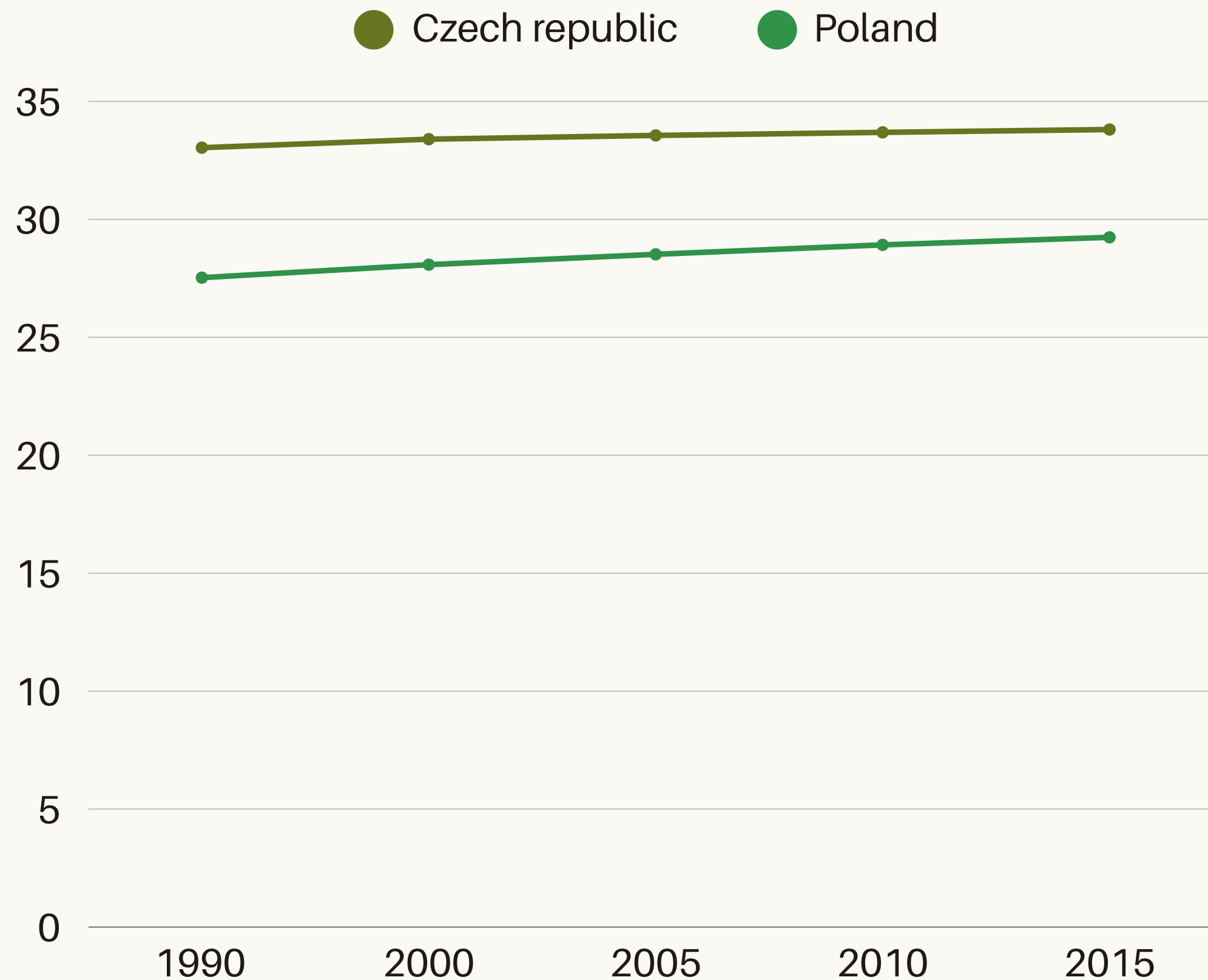
in Poland

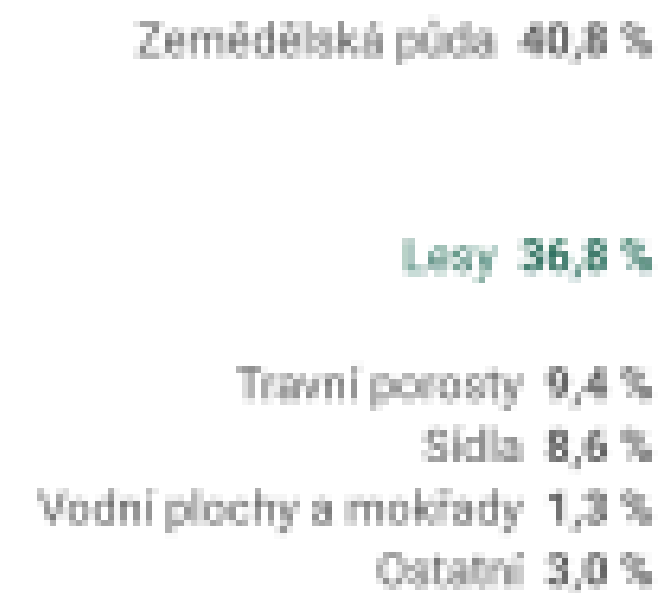


How many percent of trees were cut down in Czech republic and Poland. In the orther hand how many trees were planted.
